Re: Instructions to prepare for pest control services for the control of German Cockroaches.

Dear Tenant,

Below is a list of instructions and suggestions to help guide you through the process of preparing properly for a service to control German cockroaches. Your compliance with the following will insure you of the best service.

- <u>Inspection</u> of all rooms will be done by the technician.
- Discuss <u>sightings</u> and <u>evidence</u> with the technician. Capture several insects in a jar or container for <u>identification</u>.
- Any area where roaches have been seen should be emptied and cleaned <u>before</u> the technician arrives. (Usually kitchen <u>cabinets</u>, behind the <u>refrigerator</u> and <u>stove</u> as well as <u>bathroom cabinets</u>)
- Remember <u>you may not know where the roaches are hiding</u> so the more you prepare for treatment the better.
- It will be necessary that all <u>baseboards be cleared</u> prior to service. <u>Move all items</u> two
 (2) feet from the walls <u>where possible</u>.
- We will spray dressers and drawers only if all the <u>clothing is removed</u>.
- Be prepared to leave your apartment for a period of <u>four (4) hours</u> after it has been serviced.
- <u>Humans and pets should not touch treated areas until the material has dried.</u>
- After service is completed, <u>allow four (4) hours</u> to permit the cabinets to <u>dry</u> and then place <u>NON-ADHESIVE</u> shelf paper down before putting anything back in the cabinets
- <u>Clean only counters and other surfaces where food and utensils are used or stored.</u>
