As of November 19, 2001, the New Jersey DEP Pesticide Control Program instituted a new program that requires us to provide customers with information about the pesticides we will be using as part of the pest control program for your property. This CONSUMER INFORMATION NOTICE provides you with this information. This CIN lists any label precautions for the pesticide(s) listed below that you should be aware of. You should also be aware that you may request notification of the exact date(s) of any pesticide application, and a copy of the label for each pesticide that will be used.

Call (973) 398-0990 if you have any questions about a specific pesticide or how to prepare for treatment. Different species of insects, rodents and animals require different techniques for control. Please be as specific as possible when reporting a sighting or infestation. Details will help in the control and locating the source. Samples of the infestation are helpful in identification.

As the customer, you are entitled by the New Jersey Pesticide Control Regulations to ask us for a copy of the label for each pesticide that will be used on your property, and if you request them, we are required to provide them to you. Furthermore, if this is a contract for termite control, we are required to give you, without your asking for them a copy of a summarization of the New Jersey Pesticide Control Program's Regulations regarding proper application of termiticides.

Sanitation, as well as physical and biological control measures, should be considered as a part of a good pest control program. Pesticides may be used as another part of a good pest control program. Pesticides are substances used to control living organisms and vary in degree of toxicity.

As the customer, I acknowledge that Moore Control Exterminating Co. has provided me, in writing, all the information required by the NJ DEP Pesticide Control Program's notification program. I have read the information supplied and understand my rights and responsibilities under this program.

PRECAUTIONS:

There are basic precautions and instructions for any chemical, pesticide, rodenticide, herbicide, etc. Refer to the label for specific hazards to humans and domestic animals. The applicator may have specific instructions and precautions that must be followed before an application can take place. Upon your request, specific label instructions will be supplied.

- 1. Humans and pets should not contact treated areas until the spray has dried.
- 2. Avoid breathing vapors or contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
- 3. Cover or remove all food and food processing equipment during an application if necessary.
- 4. Food processing equipment and food-contacting surfaces should be washed following an application if contacted by a pesticide.
- 5. Ventilate the area following treatment, if prescribed by the applicator.
- 6. Do not re-enter the area following a treatment, if that is prescribed by the applicator.
- 7. RODENT BAITS ONLY-If swallowed, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding.
