PRECAUTIONS:

There are basic precautions and instructions for any chemical, pesticide, rodenticide, herbicide, etc. Refer to the label for specific hazards to humans and domestic animals. The applicator may have specific instructions and precautions that must be followed before an application can take place. Upon your request, specific label instructions will be supplied.

1. Humans and pets should not contact treated areas until the spray has dried.
2. Avoid breathing vapors or contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
3. Cover or remove all food and food processing equipment during an application if necessary.
4. Food processing equipment and food-contacting surfaces should be washed following an application if contacted by a pesticide.
5. Ventilate the area following treatment, if prescribed by the applicator.
6. Do not re-enter the area following a treatment, if that is prescribed by the applicator.
7. RODENT BAITES ONLY-If swallowed, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding.
